YPF and Neuquén establish a framework for the development of Argentina LNG

Buenos Aires, June 6, 2026 – YPF and the Government of the Province of Neuquén have signed a memorandum of understanding that establishes the regulatory and fiscal framework for the development of the Argentina LNG project in the province.

The agreement, which will be submitted to the provincial Legislature for ratification, aims to create predictable and competitive conditions to advance a strategic initiative for the country.

Under this framework, YPF commits to carrying out infrastructure investments of approximately USD 175 million, aimed at supporting the development of the project and enhancing its economic impact in the province.

The entry into force of the agreement will be subject both to legislative approval and to the adoption of the project's Final Investment Decision (FID).

With this understanding, Neuquén and YPF move forward in consolidating a development scheme that will enable the monetization of Vaca Muerta's resources, promote job creation, and strengthen Argentina's position as a global energy supplier.

Acerca de Argentina LNG:

Argentina LNG es un proyecto de gas a gran escala, que integra upstream y midstream, diseñado para desarrollar los recursos de Vaca Muerta y abastecer a los mercados internacionales. Se espera que alcance exportaciones, por hasta 12 millones de toneladas anuales de GNL para 2030 con la posibilidad de escalar a 18 MTPA.
